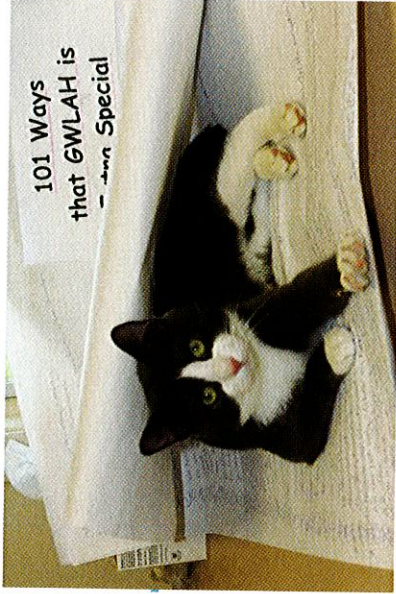
Senior Well-Care

Medical Diagnostics

Our in house laboratory is equipped to perform immediate diagnostic testing. Our equipment includes a microscope, Pulse Oximeter, CBC/Blood Chemistry Analyzer. Tonometry and doppler blood pressure monitoring are also available. We offer on site digital full body and dental x-rays, ECGs, abdominal ultrasounds and echocardiograms. Our outside laboratory facility also offers a wide range of medical testing to help ensure the most accurate and warranted screenings are available to your pet.

Inoculations

Vaccinations help prevent the spread of fatal and debilitating diseases. Prevention can assure beneficial quality of life for your pet at a lower cost than treating the disease. For more information, kindly refer to the Vaccination Protocol brochure.

Vaccine Schedules/Titer Testing

Vaccine schedules are determined by your pet's age and the risk of exposure. Our doctors will discuss these factors and set a personalized schedule for your pet. Additionally, we offer *titer testing* to clients who wish to ensure their pet has adequate protection with the least amount of vaccine.

Fecal Examination

Analysis of your pet's stool can identify intestinal parasites and infectious diseases. Often, parasites are too small to be visible without the aid of a microscope and lab analysis. We recommend bi-annual fecal testing and monthly preventatives to ensure your pet's health. For more detailed information, kindly refer *The Scoop on Poop* brochure.

Medical Boarding

We offer medical boarding for patients that need special medical care and attention, on a limited basis.

Contagious Disease Ward

We isolate pets with contagious diseases in a separate ward for their medical care.

Surgical Procedures

Our surgical suite is designed and equipped with the same life monitoring technology you expect at a human hospital. Separate feline and canine surgical recovery wards offer a peaceful hygienic place for your pet to safely recover after surgery. While being monitored by our surgical technicians, pain management and assessment is of the utmost importance during your pets recovery.

Spay and Neuter

Spaying and neutering are safe, routinely performed surgical procedures which provide many advantages to your pet's health. Spaying and neutering at a young age may beneficially alter your pet's behavior and generally eliminate or significantly reduce certain common health issues associated with intact animals that may become prevalent as they get older. Skin Testing

Like humans, pets have multiple types of skin issues related to allergies. Allergies can be related to food, sensitivity to the environment or a reaction to parasites such as fleas and ear mites. Sneezing, scratching, hair loss, foul odor, and scooting can be signs that your pet suffers from allergies. In addition to a physical exam, we offer skin cytology and blood tests to determine the cause of the irritant.

Laser Therapy

Class IV Laser Therapy is a surgery-free, drug-free, non-invasive treatment to reduce pain and inflammation and accelerate healing. Laser therapy is used to heal chronic and acute conditions such as degenerative joint disease, arthritis, tendonitis, wounds, skin allergies, lick granulomas, etc.

Microchipping

Microchipping provides your pet with a permanent and lifetime identification, offering the best chance to return home safely if lost.
