

Dear Graduate Faculty, Coordinators, and Graduate students,
Our analytics indicate that those students who receive writing instruction and consultation early in their graduate programs complete their degree requirements sooner. All of our programs are free of charge and are designed for graduate student writers at all levels and stages.

[EAL Graduate Writing Camp \(May 28-31\)](#) is a one-week summer program designed to help graduate students with English as an additional language develop long-term editing strategies to help them write more clearly for their graduate proposals, dissertations, or major research papers.

[Presentation Boot Camp \(June 15\)](#) is an intensive one-day workshop to help you refine your presentation skills.

[Brainfood Thesis and Dissertation Workshops \(starts June 18\)](#) offers sessions on proposal writing, literature reviews, time management, research, presentation skills, and much more to accommodate students at the various stages of graduate school and the thesis process. Attend one session or attend them all. You'll find out more about how to approach your research and writing with confidence.

[Dissertation Boot Camp \(June 25-29, application deadline May 14\)](#) is a one-week program designed to help students develop effective writing skills and habits to help them finish their graduate theses in a timely manner. We encourage students to apply for this program in the earlier stages of their writing process.

Writing Consultations:

- **[25-minute and 50-minute Writing appointments](#)** are available Monday-Fridays in the Library Learning Commons. Meet with a Writing Services' staff or TA in person (or online, if available) to get feedback, ask questions, or talk through your ideas.
- **[English Language appointments](#)** are effective for helping graduate students with English as an additional language clarify their ideas and structure their documents before sending drafts to their professors and supervisors.

Other Writing Programs for Graduate Students:

- **Academic Writing Style** is designed to help you improve your ability to write academically.
- **Writing Tune-Up** provides two days of grammar instruction each semester for all writers.
- **Pronunciation Group (EAL)** provides verbal communication practice for graduate-level students with English as an additional language.
- **Writing in the Sciences** is a five-part series designed to assist graduate students in improving their writing for assignments and graduate theses in the sciences. Attend one session or attend them all. (Fall & Winter only.)
- **Talk like an Academic / Write like an Academic (EAL)** are two programs that offer academic communication support for graduate-level students with English as an additional language. (Fall & Winter only.)
