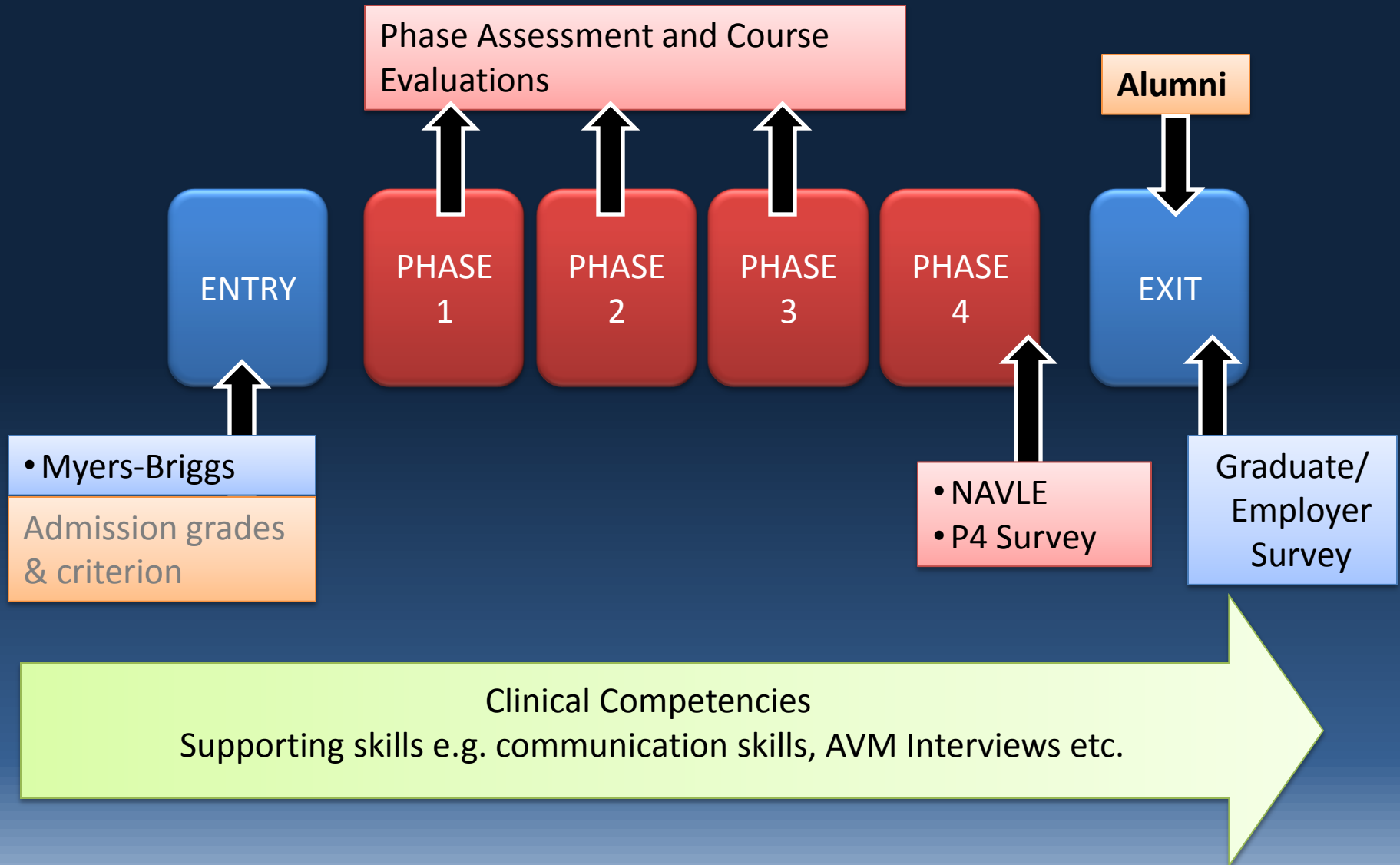

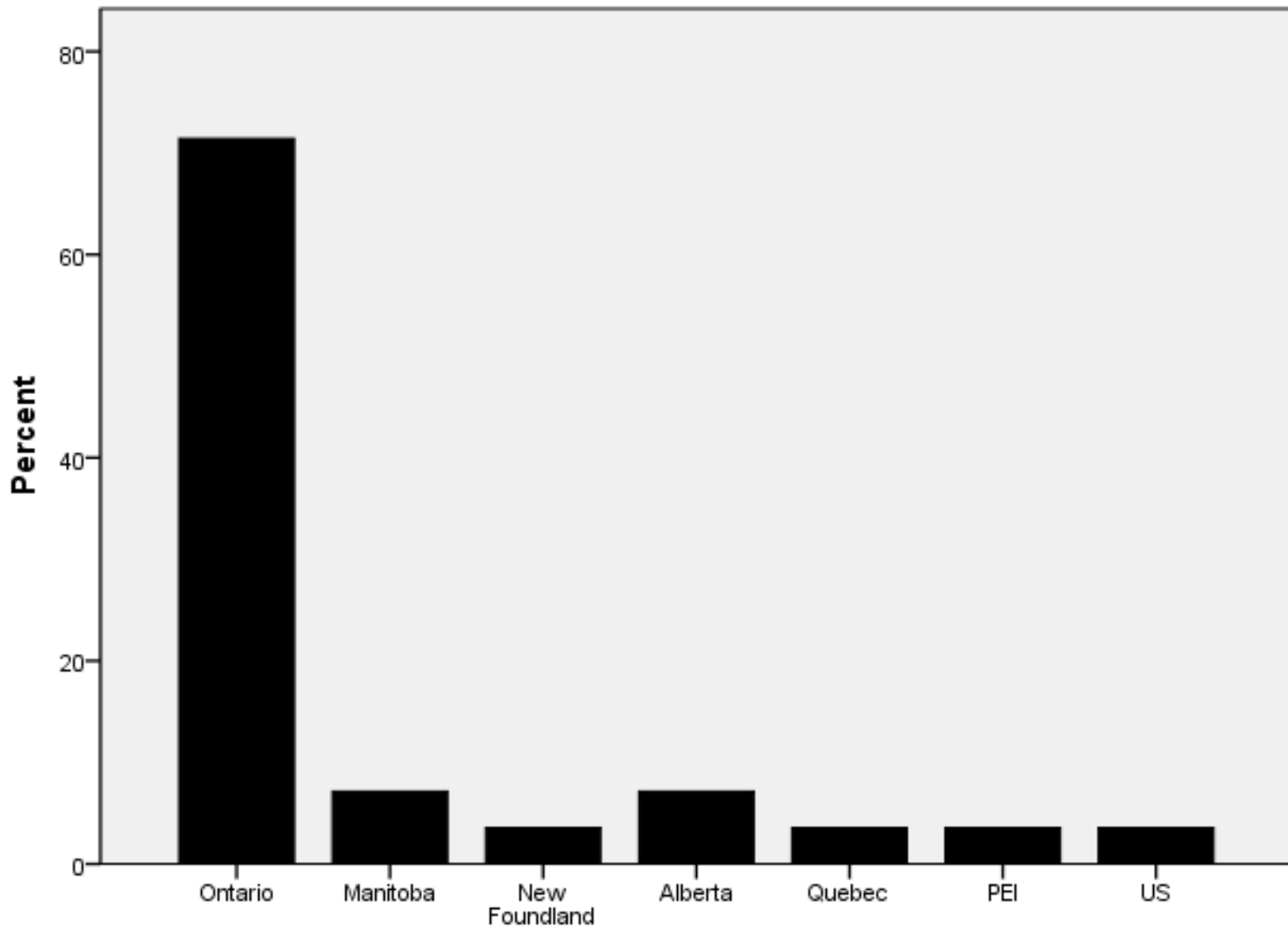
Methodology & Reporting

- Descriptive statistics are presented on a number of parameters

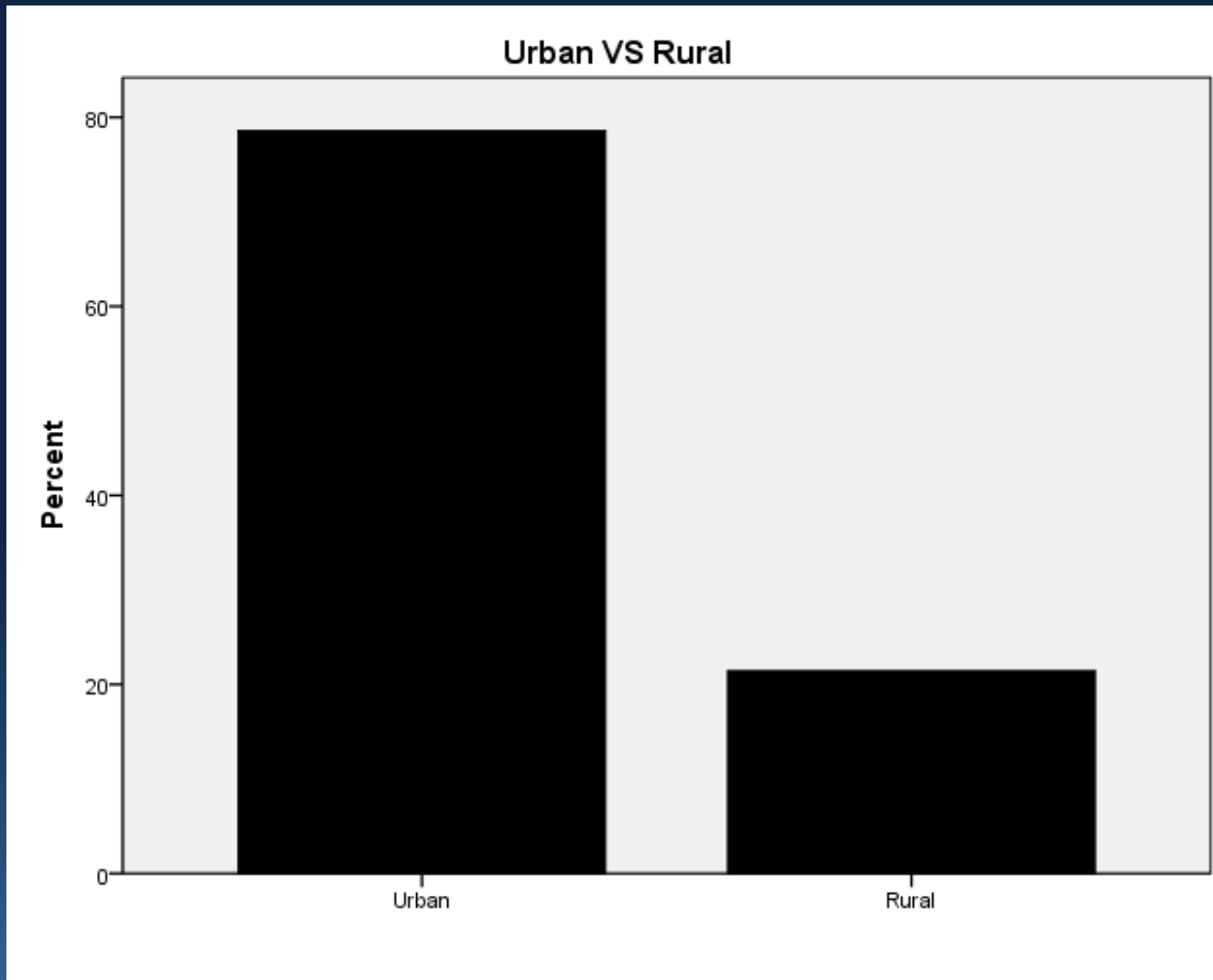

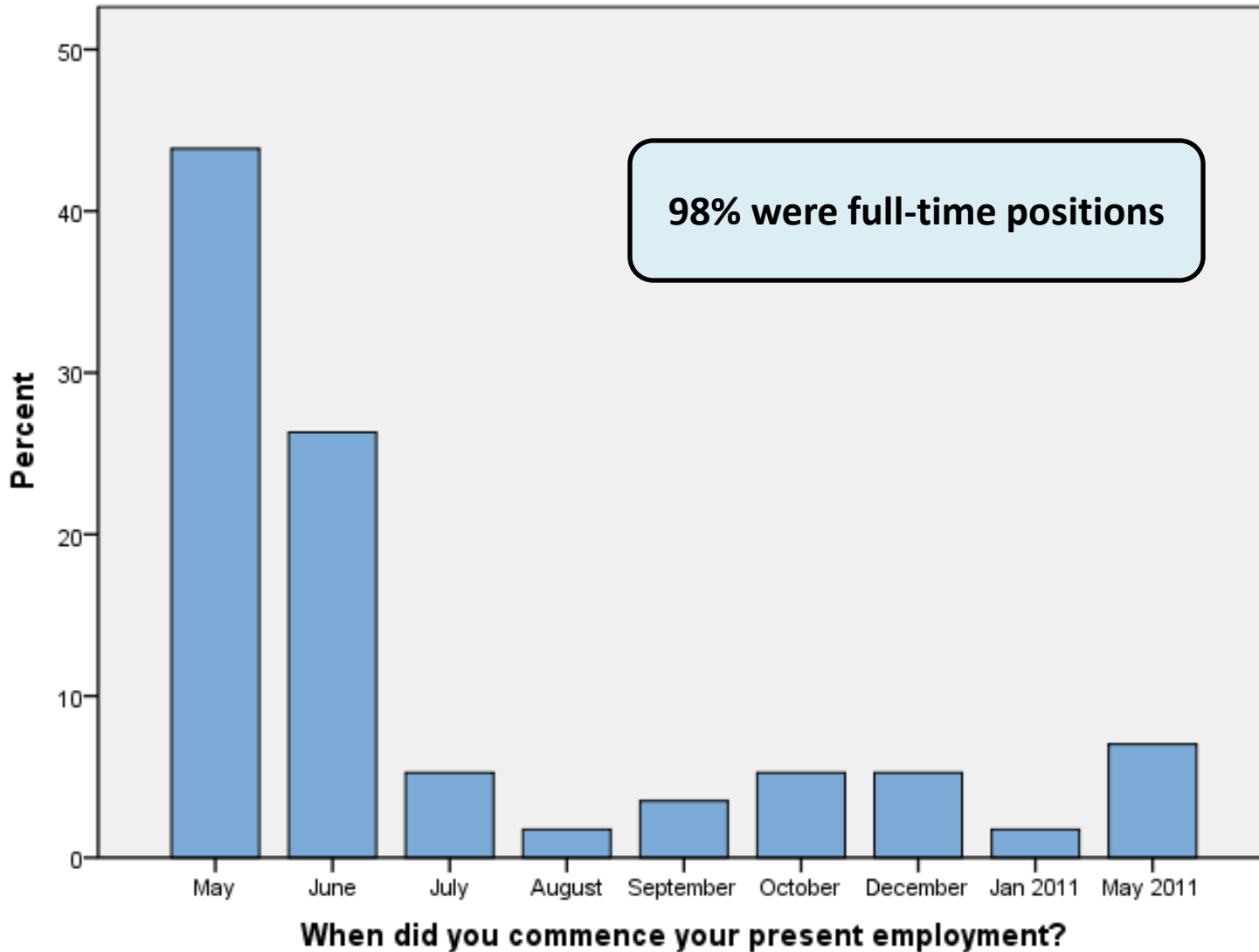

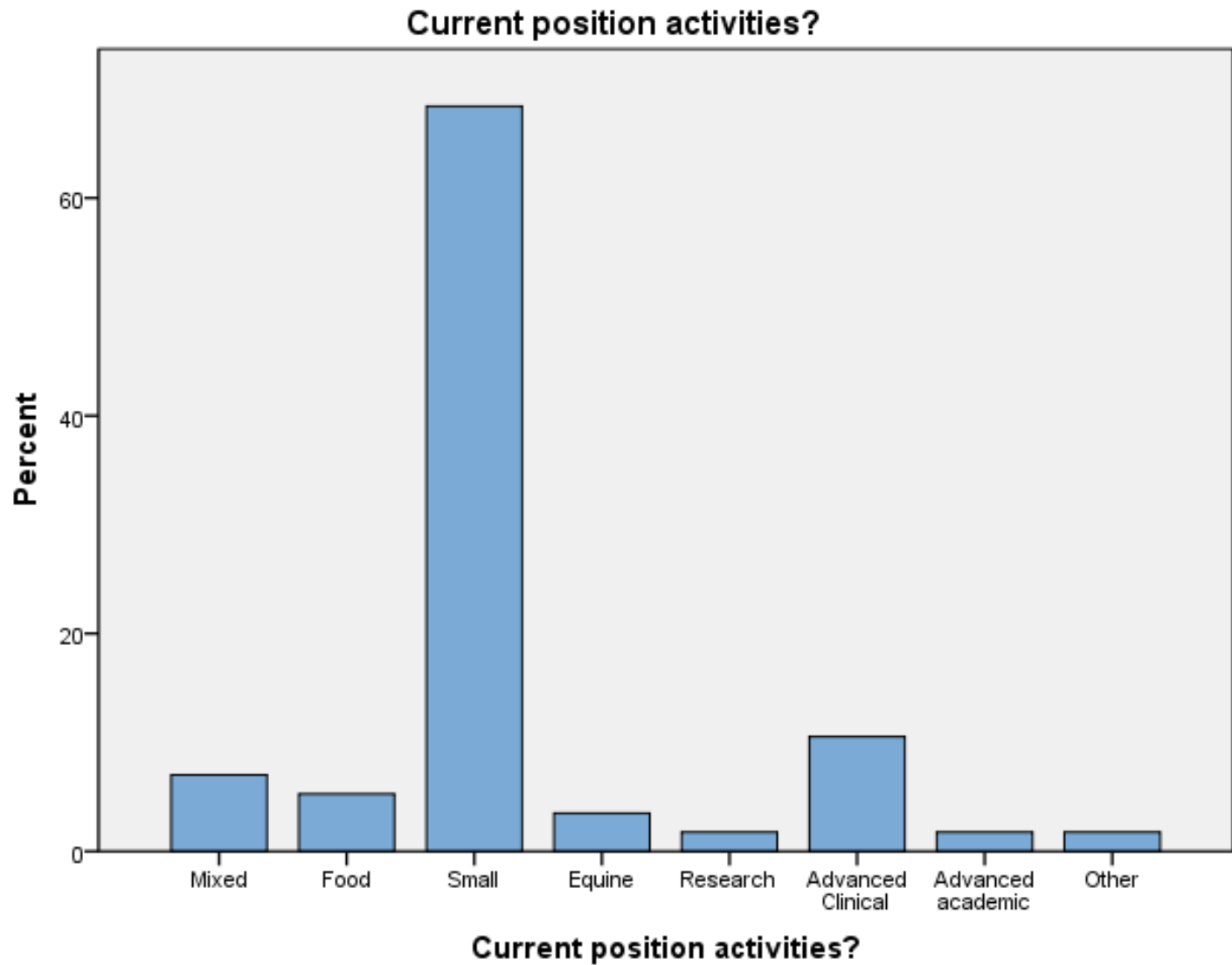

When did you commence your present employment?



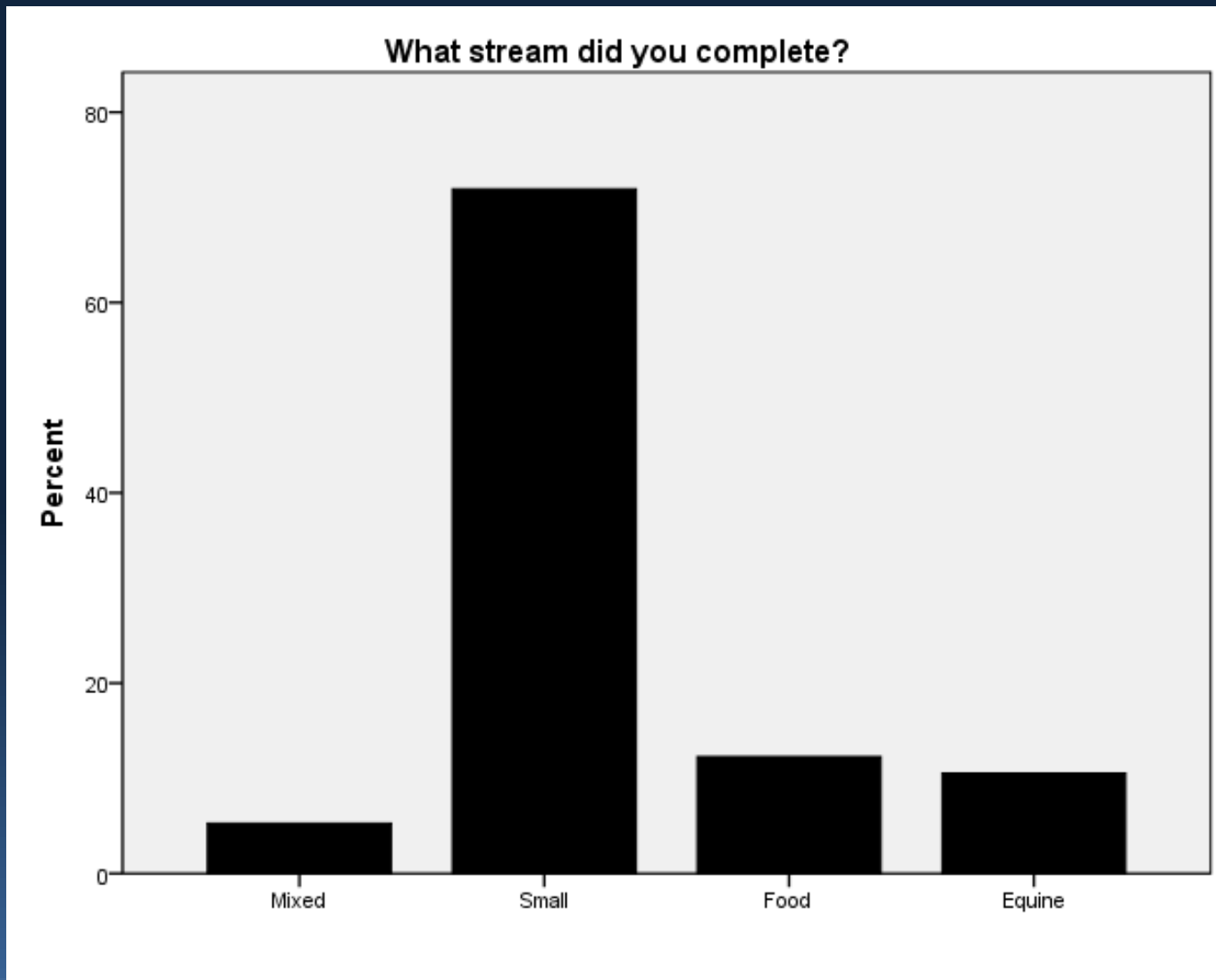
Employer responses n = 43

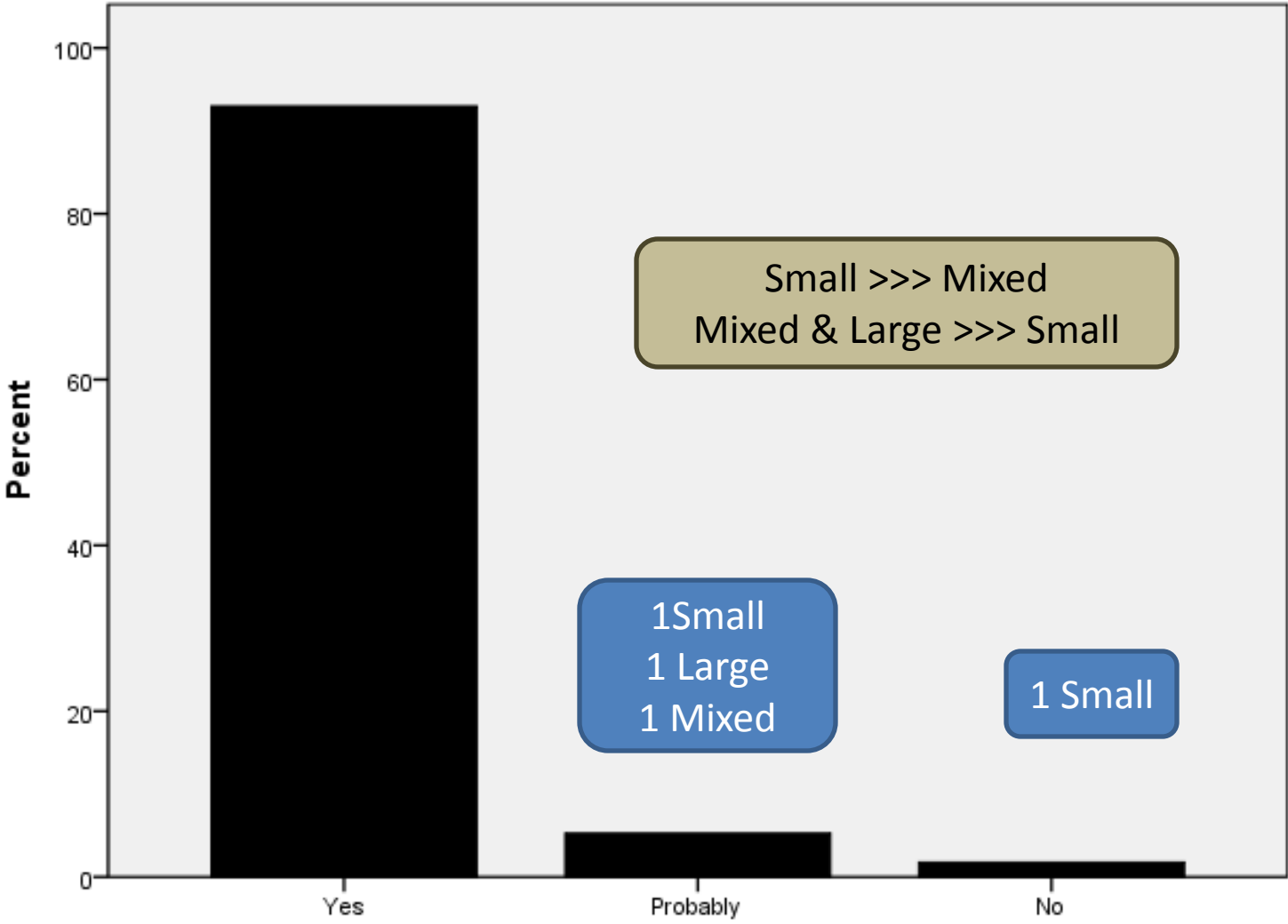

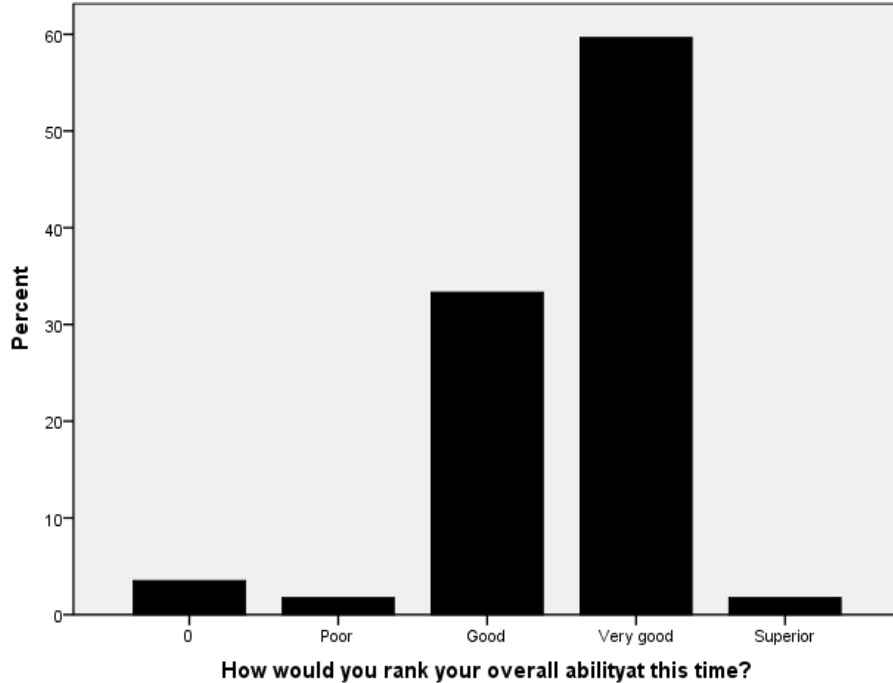
Was your stream choice appropriate?



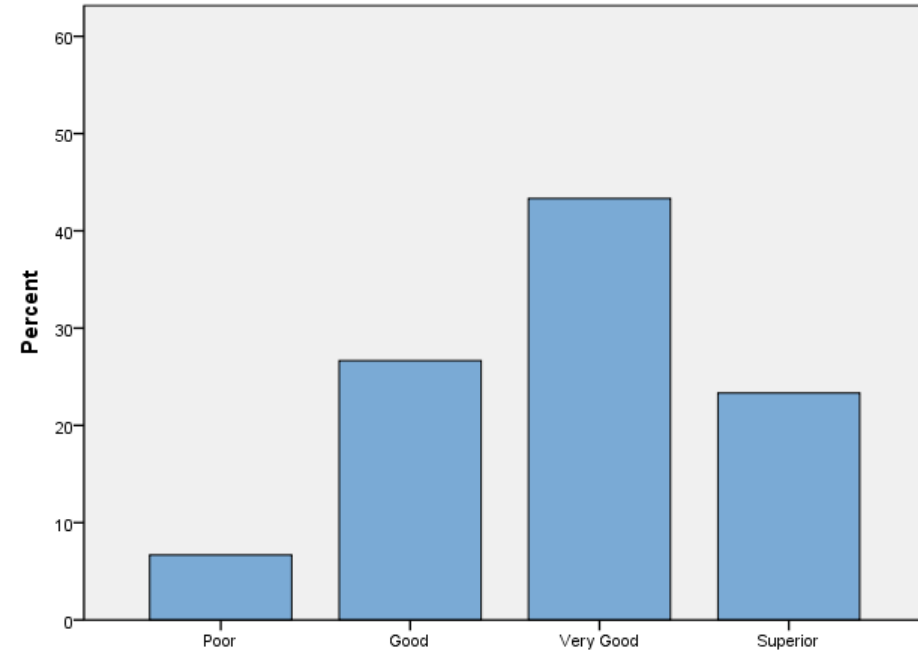

How would you rank your overall ability at this time?



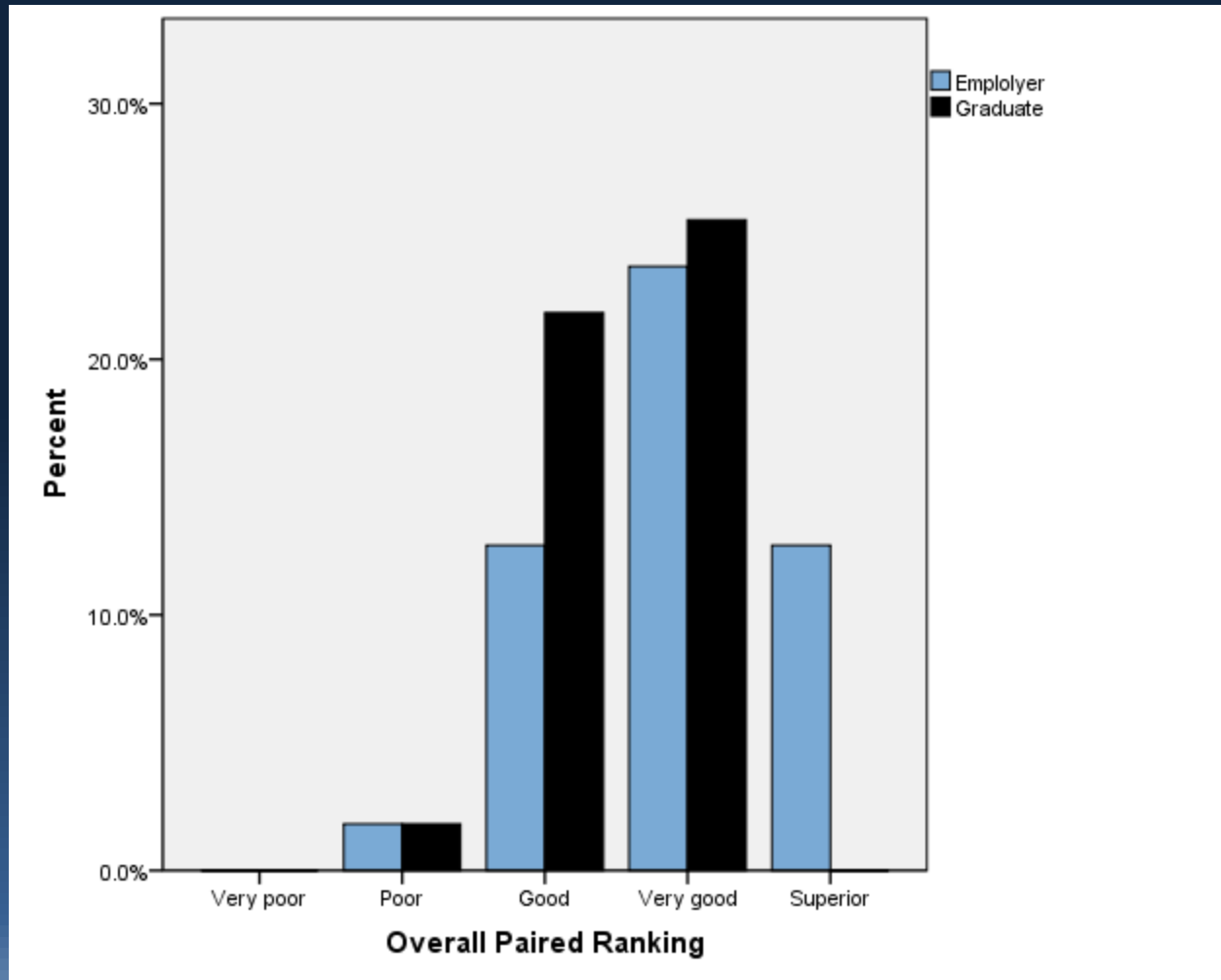
Overall Ability

Overall ability – Data Pairs

Employer comments

- More hands-on experience / lack of experience – 35%
- Inability to manage case load – 21%
- Communication skills with client and employer/fellow workers – 17%
- Happy with current employee – 8%

Graduate comments

- More hands-on experience – 36%
- Curriculum focused on unnecessary material – 25%
- Lack of experience/little confidence – 24%
- Communication with clients -7%
- Managing cases – 7%
- Felt well prepared – 3%
