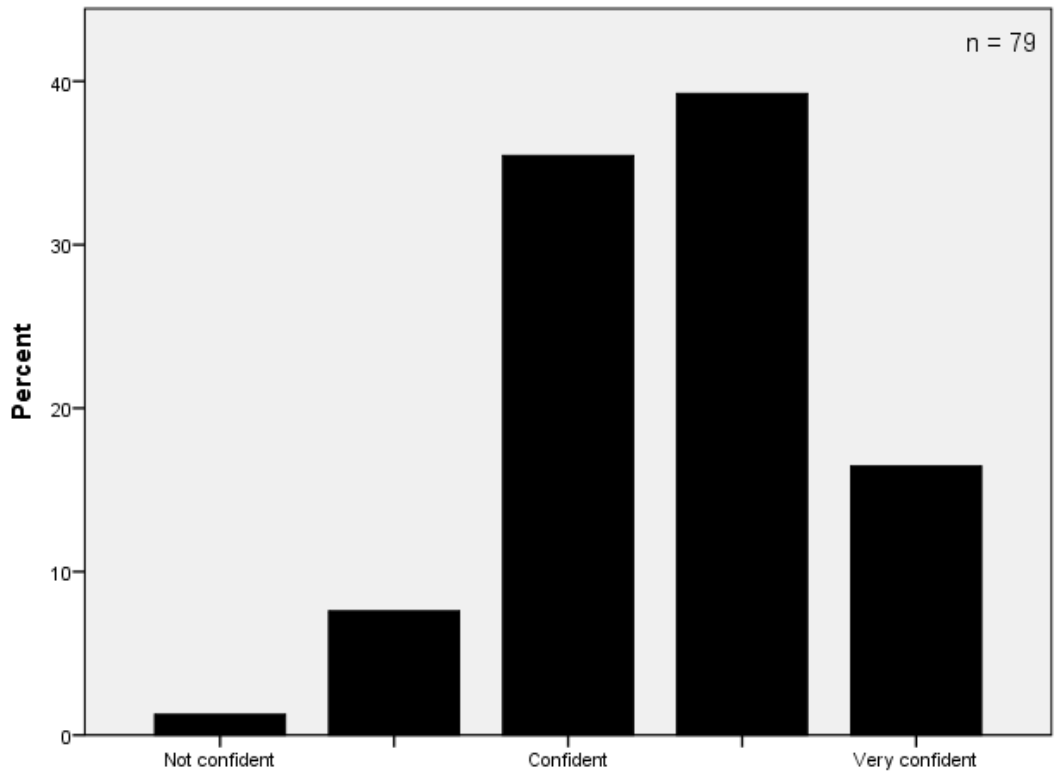
**Conducting Veterinary Activities 1: Perform a thorough routine physical examination**



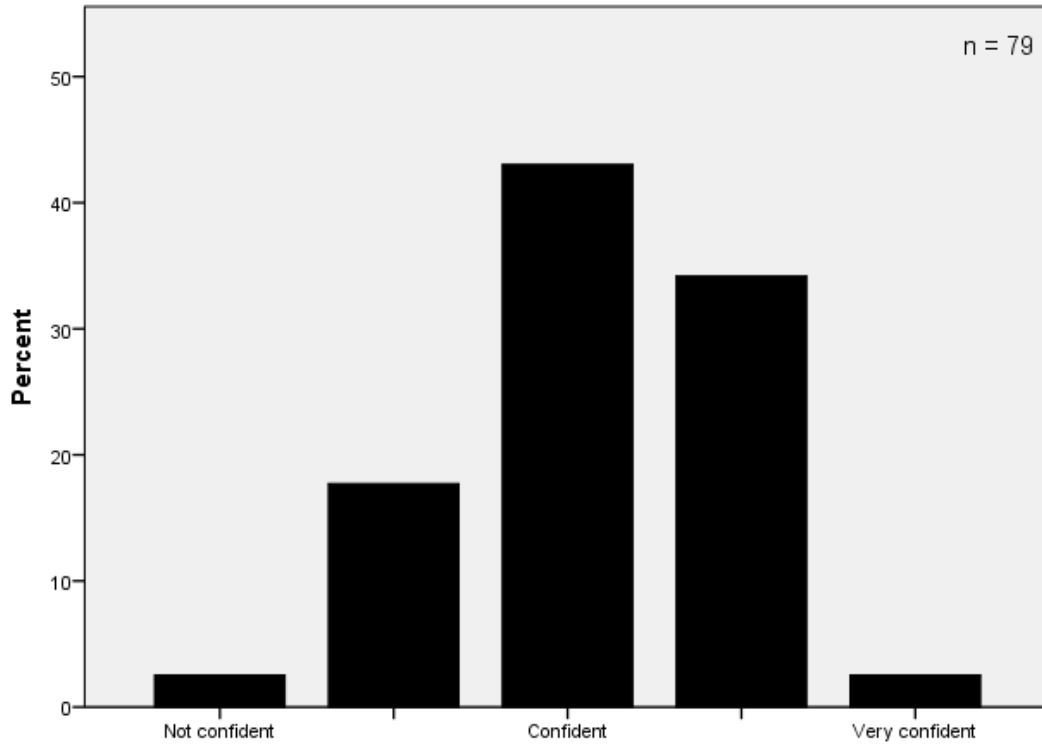
**Conducting Veterinary Activities 2: Plan and perform appropriate analgesic and anesthetic techniques commonly used in primary care practice**



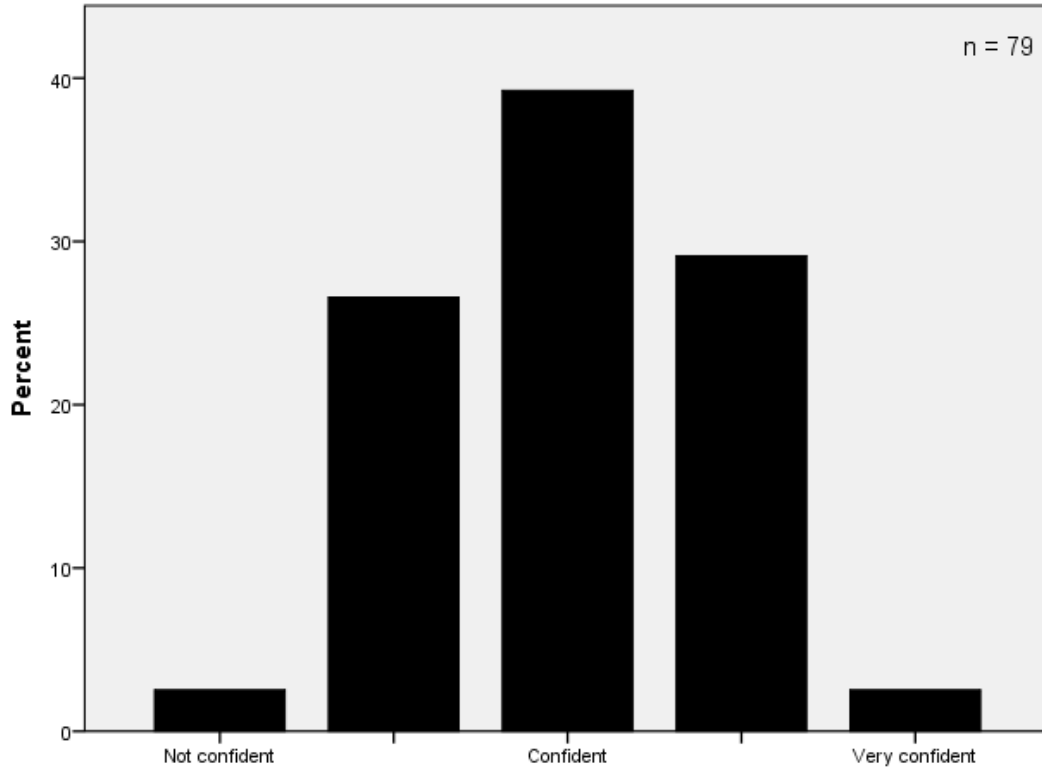
